TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS

1. All competitors must present their official Golf Canada membership card to the registration table before the start of play. During tournaments that have a “Net” or “Handicap” division, a print-out of the competitor’s Handicap Card from the RCGA Network Scoring Record must be shown to the registration table before the start of play.

Failure to comply PENALTY – 2 strokes, each day. If the card is not produced by the final day it will result in disqualification.

2. **Dress** – BCGA dress code is to be adhered to during play, and while on the golf course property, during the days of the tournament. Dress code – Full-length slacks, plus fours, tailored rugby pants and tailored shorts (max. distance 6 inches above the kneecap). Golf shirts must have collars, and be worn inside the slacks or shorts. Denims, sweat pants, tennis shorts, cutoffs, gym shorts, and shirts with slogans, numbers and offensive illustrations are prohibited. This dress code will also apply to caddies. The dress code of the host club, if more restrictive, will apply.

3. **Conduct** – Entrants are warned that conduct considered being detrimental to the best interests of the game, or unbecoming of a contestant, either on or off the course, and coming to the attention of the Tournament Committee, will be strictly dealt with, or may result in the disqualification of the offending person(s).

4. **Withdrawals** – A withdrawal form must be completed by any competitor withdrawing during the course of an event. The reason given must be on medical or compassionate grounds acceptable to the Tournament Chairman, and the Tournament Discipline Committee. Failure to provide an acceptable reason will result in automatic suspension of the privilege to play in ALL of next year’s events sanctioned or conducted by the BCGA Zone Committee.

5. **Failure to attend** – Should the entrant be accepted in the tournament, and fail to attend for any part of the tournament, the same reasons as above must apply. If the reason is not satisfactory, the same penalties will apply.

6. Further regulations and conditions of play will be provided to all competitors in the form of their Notice to Competitors, at registration.

7. The contestant waiver form below must be signed by the applicants.

Waiver – This contestant waiver must be signed by the applicant, in consideration of the BCGA Zone 5 Men’s Committee accepting this entry, and the inherent risks associated with this event. The applicant is aware of, and assumes all risks of bodily injury or property damage, including specifically, (but not exclusively), the risk of being injured by thrown or struck golf balls, or clubs, actions by spectators, players, caddies, or others in attendance. The applicant agrees that the BCGA, including its Directors, Officers and employees, as well as the other competitors in the tournament, are not liable for any injuries or property damage resulting from such causes or any other negligence.
